Rationale

At St Jerome's School students are obliged to wear the school uniform provided by the St Jerome's Uniform Shop at an economical charge. This obligation is provided for in the contract between parent and school. The uniform provides a recognisable face to the school on excursions.

Principles

1. The school uniform is to be worn with pride and all articles of clothing to be worn correctly.
2. The school uniform is an integral part of school policy and is therefore at the Principal's discretion.
3. It is assumed that the P&F will make recommendations regarding the suitability of articles of uniform to the Principal from time to time.

Procedures

1. Summer uniform to be worn in terms 1 and 4
2. Winter uniform to be worn in terms 2 and 3
3. Hats to be worn all year [outside]
4. Sports uniform to be worn only on sports days
5. Graduation shirts to be worn on sports days and as required by staff.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS:

Kindergarten school t-shirts are available but are not compulsory

PRE-PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM

Boys and Girls (Terms 1 & 4)

Kindy/Pre-Primary t-shirt
Bottle green unisex shorts with school name imprinted
Sports shoes
School hat with crest

Boys and Girls (Terms 2 & 3)

Kindy/Pre-Primary t-shirt
Bottle green school tracksuit jacket
Bottle green school tracksuit pants
Sports shoes- predominantly white
School hat with crest

YEARS 1 TO 6

Girls Summer Uniform (Terms 1 & 4)

Summer dress
Plain white socks ('fold over' type not sports socks)
Black school shoes
School hat with crest

Girls Winter Uniform (Terms 2 & 3)

Tartan skirt
Tartan tie (Years 4-6 only)
Lemon long or short sleeve shirt with crest
Bottle jumper with school crest
Black tights or white 'fold over' socks and
Black school shoes
School hat with crest

Boys Summer Uniform (Terms 1 & 4)

Short sleeve lemon shirt with school crest
WA Grey elastic backed shorts
Grey ankle sock with gold and bottle green stripes
Black school shoes
School hat with crest

Boys Winter Uniform (Terms 2 & 3)

Lemon long or short sleeve shirt with crest
Tartan tie (Years 4-6 only)
WA Grey elastic backed trousers or shorts
Grey socks with green and gold bands
Black school shoes
School hat with crest

Sport Uniform

Bottle green/faction sport shirt
Bottle green unisex short with school name imprinted
Bottle green microfibre tracksuit top with school crest, gold stripe on the sleeves
Bottle green microfibre tracksuit pants with gold stripe
St Jerome's sport sock not plain white
Predominantly white runners. NB: **BLACK OR COLOURED RUNNERS ARE NOT PERMITTED**
School hat with crest

For clarification

School shoes heel is to be no more than 3cm in height.
Black "school shoes" suggests the type of shoe that is similar to the type manufactured by Clarkes, Bata Scouts or Rivers. Suede or canvas type shoes are not classified as "school shoes" and are not permitted.
Velcro, buckle or lace-up shoes are all permitted.

Jewellery and Accessories

1. Only sleepers or plain gold /silver studs for pierced ears; one sleeper or stud in each ear in the lower lobe. This applies to both boys and girls.
2. Expensive jewellery should not be worn to school.
3. One gold or silver chain with a religious symbol may be worn around the neck under the dress or collar.
4. A wrist watch.
5. No other jewellery is allowed.
6. Hair tidily arranged and tied back if it reaches the collar. No fashionable hair styles or cuts permitted **e.g. no undercuts, stencilling or unnatural colouring.**
7. Only bottle green scrunchies and hair accessories may be worn.
8. No nail polish or false nails to be worn.
